



2026 Wine Festival Beverage Regulations

April 11th, 2026

12:00PM to 6:00PM

Rain or Shine Event

1) The event is scheduled from 12:00 PM to 6:00 PM. Vendor booths must always be staffed during event hours. Upon receiving your location map, you will also receive a designated check-in time and additional set-up instructions. All booth setup, including the removal of vehicles, must be completed by 10:00 AM. Vehicles will not be permitted back onto the event grounds until teardown begins after 6:00 PM on Saturday. You will be notified by CLCOC Staff or Volunteer when you can go retrieve your vehicle.

3) **Space is limited.** Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. All fees must accompany the attached registration form. Checks should be made payable to the Clarksville Lake Country COC, 105 2nd St. Clarksville, VA 23927. If you are not accepted, you will be notified and asked if you would like the check to be mailed back or shredded. Subletting space to another vendor is prohibited.

4) Beverage vendors must provide their own tables, chairs, tents, display racks, and all setup materials. The festival provides space only. Vendors are responsible for weather protection. Proof of insurance covering event participation must be submitted with the application. Wineries must have required remote permits on file and be prepared for ABC inspection. All vendors must comply with all state and ABC regulations regarding the sale of alcoholic beverages.

5) The Clarksville Lake Country Chamber of Commerce and Clarksville Lake Country Wine Festival are not responsible for loss of inventory or loss or damage to work or other property of vendors and/or participants.

6) No signage/promotion, etc. may reflect the logos of alcoholic beverages other than wines sold at the festival. **You may not display items not approved for sale.**

7) Each vendor is responsible for keeping the area in and around the vendor's space neat and free from garbage and the discarding of wine bottles, seals & corks. All Beverage will be charged a \$75 post-event clean-up fee if they do not meet these requirements. Vendors are responsible for water casks for glass rinsing if desired.

8) 10) Please be advised that due to ABC regulations and regulations of the Clarksville Lake Country Chamber of Commerce, **no one under the age of 21 is permitted on the festival grounds.**

9) Vendor's employees or contract associates of any kind participating in booth activities must have appropriate "ID" as evidence to show at entrance gates for admittance.

10) Vendors are responsible for the collection of Virginia State sales tax and maintenance of applicable required documentation.

11) There will be **no refunds** made for spaces once you have been accepted as a participant in the Clarksville Lake Country Wine Festival.

12) Pets are not allowed on the festival grounds. No alcoholic beverages other than those purchased at the festival are permitted. Any item displaying profanity or discriminatory symbols, words, etc. is strictly prohibited.

14)Remember to list the wines you will be offering to the tasters (minimum of 5).

MISCELLANEOUS

- a) **Force Majeure and Cancellation:** This event is held "Rain or Shine." However, should the Chamber be forced to cancel the festival due to a *force majeure* event (circumstances beyond our reasonable control), the vendor's sole remedy shall be a full refund of the paid booth fee. The Chamber is not liable for any other costs incurred by the vendor. We advise all participants to carry independent weather insurance. There is no rain date for this event.
- b) Upon execution of this agreement and as a part of the consideration hereof, the vendor agrees to indemnify and hold the Clarksville Lake Country Chamber of Commerce, and all of the Clarksville Lake Country Chamber of Commerce officers, directors, sponsors, employees, and agents, harmless from any debts, accounts, suits, cause of action, actions, proceedings, claims, liabilities, demands and judgments, which may include, but are not limited to all costs, expenses, damages and attorney's fees, arising out of, because of, or in connection with any act or failure to act by vendor's agents, invites, employees, representatives or servants in the activities contemplated by this agreement, in connection with the failure of any apparatus, equipment or personal property used by vendor in the activities contemplated by the agreement, or in connection with vendor participation in the Clarksville Lake Country Wine Festival. The vendor agrees to provide a certificate of insurance covering participation in the event with the application.
- c) This agreement contains the entire understanding of the parties concerning the matters contained herein. The agreement may not be modified, except by the writing signed by both parties. This agreement supersedes all prior communications or agreements, whether written or oral, relating to the Clarksville Lake Country Wine Festival.
- d) Any problems encountered with Festival attendees should be immediately reported to Festival Management.
